<u>BIO</u>

Rebecca Lindsmyr (b.1990) is a painter working in the intersections of painterly discourses and psychoanalytic, linguistic, and post-structuralist thought. Through a diverse painterly approach, her work explores the constructions of self within and through painting. As a medium for external depiction or a receptor of expressive indexical marks, painting is closely tied to notions of self. This dual gaze is played on in considering the self's slippages between subject and object; identification and othering; inside and outside; semiotic and symbolic. Emphasis is placed on psychoanalytic ideas of the pre-symbolic, the abject and the mirror stage; ideas focusing on the self as not-yet, on the collapse of language and materiality, and on identification with a surface as a possible key in our understandings of self and other. The work hence refers to notions of borders, childhood or regression, breakdowns and build-ups of identity, language, and power.

Rebecca graduated with a *Master in Fine Art* from Malmö Art Academy (SE) in 2021, and previously holds a *BA* (Hons) Fine Art: Painting and Printmaking from Glasgow School of Art (UK). In 2021 she received the *Assistant Grant* from The Swedish Arts Grants Committee (SE), to work for the Danish artist Lea Porsager. In 2022 she received the *Ellen Trotzig Grant* from Malmö Art Museum (SE), as well as the *Anne-Marie Hökerberg-Hecht Foundation Grant* from The Royal Swedish Academy of Fine Arts (SE) which includes spending 6 months as a resident at *Cité Internationale des Arts* in Paris in 2023. In 2023 she received a *One Year Working Grant* from The Swedish Arts Grants Committee (SE). Since 2022 she is represented by Nils Staerk in Copenhagen (DK), where she held her first solo exhibition in 2022.
